



SOUHEGAN VALLEY, NH CROP HUNGER WALK

The Souhegan Valley has been sponsoring a fundraising event for church World Services (CWS) for just under 30 years. This walk's goal is to fight against global hunger. MUMC has been a part of this for several of those years. We have had as many as 98 walkers from MUMC striding the streets of Milford and Amherst raising much needed dollars for CWS. 25% of those funds stay locally and are dispersed to SHARE and Wilton Open Cupboard. Several areas churches have been supporting this mission for years, sadly only 4 churches attended the kick off meeting on March 14. The number of walkers was down significantly last year and we are hoping to get those numbers back up. On a positive note though, one 10 year old boy from the Amherst Congregational church raised over \$5000 himself last year. Now that's amazing!
